In 2018, 44 countries signed on to the African Continental Free Trade Area agreement, which, when it took effect a year ago, created the largest free-trade zone in the world. After years of negotiations it was a huge step forward and, in my view, marked a turning point: Africa would finally move toward true industrialization.

(**) consuming mostly foreign-made products, we Africans would make and trade our own goods. European and Chinese companies had already started setting up African-staffed factories on the continent, and domestic businesses would get an even bigger boost from the agreement.

For *UBI Group, the oil and gas distribution company that I founded in Ghana, this was welcome news. Our continent's industrialization would require an enormous amount of energy to propel it, and I wanted to help my country and its neighbors develop responsibly.

That's why I moved forward with my plans for a new venture: the solar-focused Blue Power Energy. Though I'd spent the previous decade working on infrastructure for storing and moving fossil fuels around Ghana, I knew that renewables were a better long-term alternative for Africa. We're currently building two solar farms in Ghana with the goal of eight more by 2028, and we're aiming to supply 3 million customers with 140 megawatts of clean energy by the end of 2023.

Success comes to those who bravely and quickly get into new markets but remain *agile—willing to *chart a different course if circumstances change. That's the *mindset with which I launched Blue Power Energy. I firmly believe that the future of our industry is in renewables: wind, hydro, geothermal, biomass, and—the most obvious choice for Africa, i given its climate—solar. Yes, I still have ties to energy's past. I can't up and leave fossil fuels at once, because they are still used and needed. But I also want to help lead the transition away from them.

Generating power ii) in this way is still more expensive than using nonrenewables in the short term. But in the long term it will be the safest, most

sensible, and least expensive way to generate and utilize energy. Clean energy will offer a greater return on investment than fossil fuels do. It is possible to earn a profit and protect the environment and our local communities at the same time. Africa can industrialize in a sustainable way, and I will do my part to promote that kind of growth and development.

Deforestation is an environmental issue that happens all over the world. It is the destruction of forests in order to make the land available for other uses or simply to extract timber. Agriculture and urbanization play an important role in deforestation as most of land clearing occurs because of ① them.

Cutting down forests has ② <u>many negative effects</u> on the environment. The most dramatic impact is the loss of habitat for millions of species. Seventy percent of Earth's land animals and plants live in forests. With the loss of habitat, many species end up isolated without enough food and shelter to sustain their existence and many become extinct.

Another side effect of deforestation is climate change. Many environmentalists believe that deforestation is also directly connected to global warming. One technique used to clear a forested area is called "slash and burn", where the trees and plants are cut down and burned. ($\mbox{\%}$), with the reduction of forests, not only is the amount of CO_2 removed from the atmosphere reduced, but also the CO_2 retained by the trees is released into the atmosphere. In fact, the process of deforestation releases as much CO_2 into our atmosphere as all the cars, trucks, and buses on our planet.

More than serving as home to animal life and cleaning our air, forests are essential to secure a stable and adequate food supply for our growing population, protect the soil against erosion and drought, and allow for sustainable agriculture.

One of the proposed solutions to deforestation is reforestation. Still, only planting trees is not enough to rebuild a forest. As with many other environmental issues, a huge effort is necessary to reduce the damage that has already been done by deforestation all over the world.
